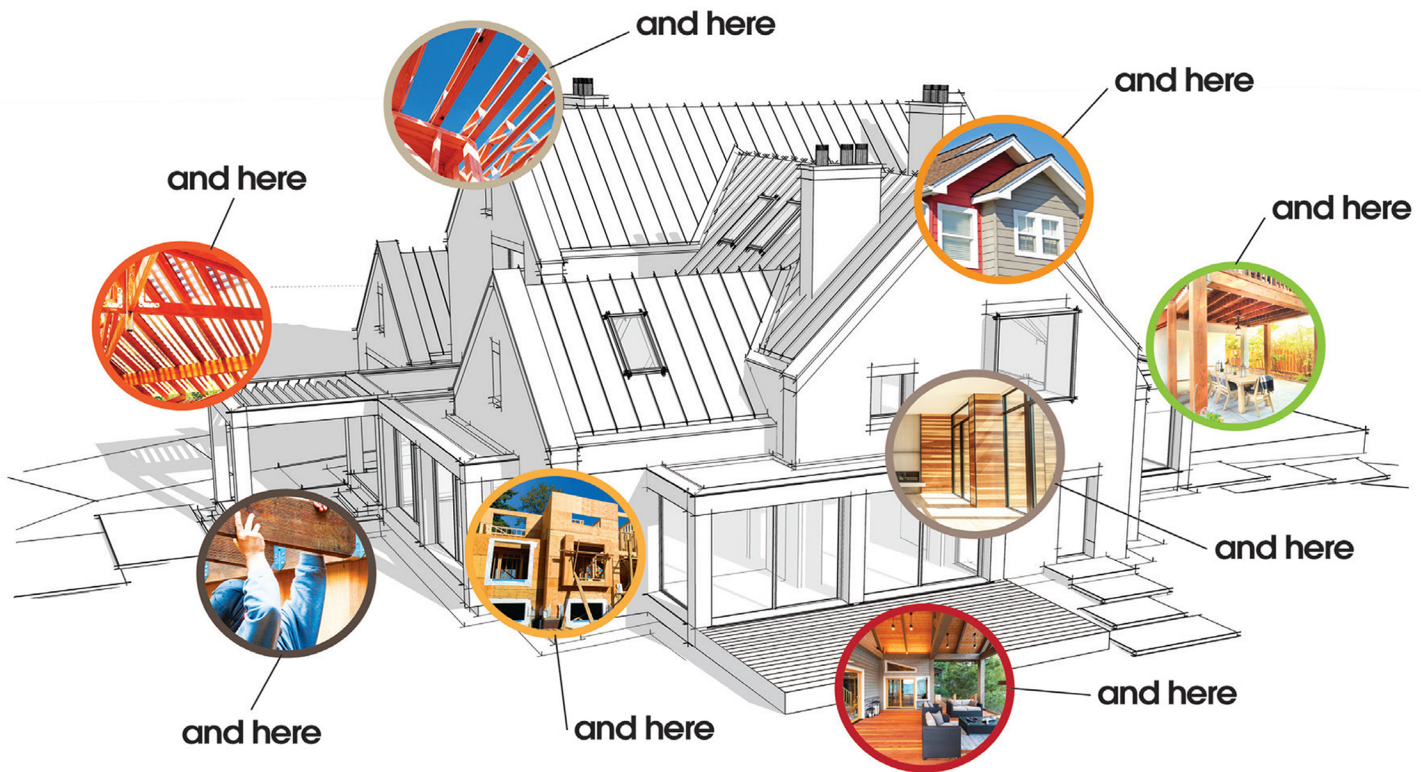

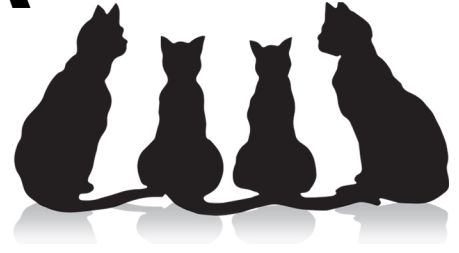


## J8 - TWIN CITIES CLUB 12
