

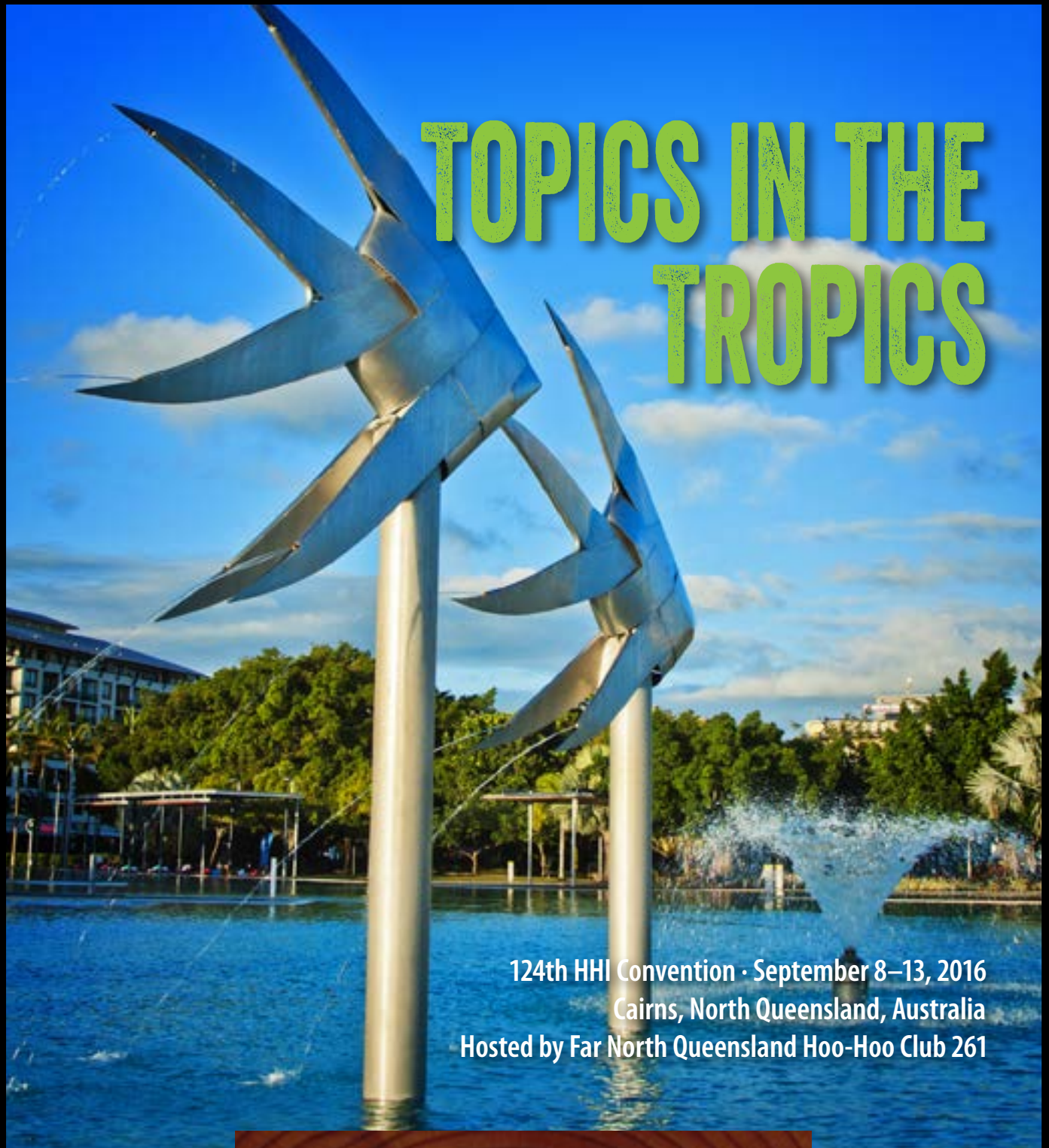

GLIDE ABOVE THE RAINFOREST CANOPY

As part of our convention time in Cairns, we will spend the day discovering the rainforest. Our adventure starts with a breathtaking journey on one of the world's most scenic train routes through hand-hewn tunnels and across bridges. The train will stop at Barron Gorge to view the amazing falls before arriving at the beautiful Kuranda Station. Here we have free time to explore the quaint village before departing for our Skyrail journey over the beautiful canopy of the rainforest.

Kuranda is a lovely little village 984 feet above sea level. The main street (about two football fields long) is comprised of cafes, restaurants and shops hosting arts and crafts. The village has three different markets, a butterfly sanctuary, bird world, koala gardens, mini crystal museum, and much more.

A short shuttle bus ride out of the village center will take us to the Rain-forestation Nature Park which offers activities such as the Wildlife Park and the Pamagirri Aboriginal Experience. Here you can learn to play the didgeridoo, discover the medicinal values of bush tucker, throw a spear and enjoy professional theatre incorporating traditional Aboriginal dance, fire making, storytelling, and more.

Next, the Skyrail Rainforest Cableway experience will have you gliding just feet above the rainforest canopy. During the trip you will descend through tree top layers and deep into the heart of the forest for stops at two rainfor-est mid-stations creating the ultimate tropical experience.

These are some of the incredible things planned on just one day to make this a truly great international convention. We hope you will make the decision to come join in all the Hoo-Hoo frolics and fun.

NOTICE OF CHANGES AND/OR AMENDMENTS TO THE CONSTITUTION OF THE INTERNATIONAL CONCATENATED ORDER OF HOO-HOO, INC.

Dear Members,

Please peruse the following pages updates to the bylaws of our Order. As per Article 18 in our constitution, it is a requirement that any proposed changes to the constitution or bylaws be posted in the LOG & TALLY prior to the annual convention. Thus this per-convention electronic supplement is to bring you these proposed changes while the new LOG & TALLY is in final print production.

The current HHI board of directors has been working hard to fine tune the structure of the organization by creating and populating various "special" committees responsible for the cohesive management of Hoo-Hoo International. Snark Bond requests that all members of good standing read through these suggested bylaw changes and respond before the start of the International convention which begins September 8, 2016, in Cairns, Australia. The goal of proposed changes are to:

- Refine and enhance the role of Vice President encouraging them to work closely with committees and the Snark to better prepare themselves for the transition to Snark.
- Add a position of 2nd Vice President which will provide depth to the executive board level for the good of the Order.
- Insert a "special" Committees section that will give the board a way to define and identify their goals and assign members to carry out those goals.
- Finally, to delete "Executive Committee" from Article 6 and move it into Article 7 with the rest of the committees.

It is my recommendation as chairman of the Good of the Order committee that we support these proposals as being approved by our committee for the benefit of Hoo-Hoo and for the Good of the Order. Please note the lettering in green for the reason for change.

Special thanks to 2nd Vice President Pieter Verlinden 92510 for drafting this proposal.

Goal for this change:

To allow any future Board of Directors to add a 2nd Vice President position, if and when a member is nominated.

Article 5 — Directors and Officers of the Order and Corporation**Section 1**

Officers and Directors of the Order and Corporation

1. Chairman
2. President (The Snark of the Universe)
3. Vice President
4. 2nd Vice President – To be added at the discretion of the HHI Board.
5. Secretary-Treasurer

Section 4

- (a) **Change the words** “Vice President” to “1st Vice President, 2nd Vice President”
- (b) **Change the words** “Vice President” to “1st Vice President, 2nd Vice President”
- (d) **Currently reads:** Following the closing of nominations the incumbent Supreme Nine members will meet in caucus with their Jurisdictions to tally the votes of each club for the office of Snark of the Universe, Vice President, and of Secretary-Treasurer. The written tally of these votes will be presented by each Supreme Nine member to the Executive Secretary to be tallied in the presence of two scrutineers appointed by the Snark from the delegates at large and the results presented to the Convention. Each Jurisdiction will elect its Supreme Nine member at this caucus and the results of their decision presented to the Executive Secretary at the same time. The Snark of the Universe is deemed to be the first elected followed by the 1st and then the Secretary-Treasurer regardless of the order in which the announcements are made. The election of the Supreme Nine members will be deemed to have taken place following the election of the officers.
- Replace by:** Following the closing of nominations the incumbent Supreme Nine members will meet in caucus with their Jurisdictions to tally the votes of each club for the office of Snark of the Universe, 1st Vice President, 2nd Vice President, and of Secretary-Treasurer. The written tally of these votes will be presented by each Supreme Nine member to the Executive Secretary to be tallied in the presence of two scrutineers appointed by the Snark from the delegates at large and the results presented to the Convention. Each Jurisdiction will elect its Supreme Nine member at this caucus and the results of their decision presented to the Executive Secretary at the same time. The Snark of the Universe is deemed to be the first elected followed by the 1st and 2nd Vice Presidents and then the Secretary-Treasurer regardless of the order in which the announcements are made. The election of the Supreme Nine members will be deemed to have taken place following the election of the officers.
- (f) **Change the words** “Vice President” to “1st Vice President, 2nd Vice President.”

**Article 6, Section 7 — Executive Committee**

Delete this from Article 6

Change Article 6, Section 8: to Article 6, Section 7

Change Article 6, Section 9: to Article 6, Section 8

Goal for this change: *This section (with amendments to allow for the inclusion of the 2nd Vice President to serve on the Executive Committee) should be under Article 7, Section 1— Committees, (a),(b),(c),(d).*

Replace Article 7 with the following:

Article 7 — Committees**Section 1: Committees**

At the opening board meeting immediately following each annual convention, the newly elected Snark will appoint the following committees to serve until the next annual convention. The members and the number appointed to each committee are at the discretion of the Board of Directors. Said committee members, where eligible and in attendance at the convention, will be appointed to the corresponding convention special committee. At each Annual Convention, the Snark of the Universe shall appoint the following committees:

Executive Committee — to consist of the Chairperson of the Board, Snark of the Universe, Secretary/Treasurer, Executive Treasurer, 1st Vice President and 2nd Vice President.

The Chairperson for this committee will be the Snark of the Universe.

- (b) Meetings of the Executive Committee may be held from time to time upon notice given by the Snark, by another officer acting on the Snark’s behalf, or by written request of three or more members of the Committee.
- (c) The Executive Committee shall have all the powers of the Board of Directors when the Board is not in session providing that any action by the Executive Committee which is contrary to any established policy of the Board of Directors or contrary to any Resolution by the Board of Directors, is approved by a majority vote of the Board of Directors prior to such action being taken. Such approval shall be in writing, facsimile or electronically and may be submitted without a meeting. No action may be taken that is contrary to the Bylaws. The Secretary-Treasurer shall cause all actions taken to be recorded in the minutes of the Corporation.
- (d) The minutes of the Executive Committee are to be submitted at the next meeting of the Board of Directors for discussion and ratification.
- Goals and Assignments
- 1) Perform to the bylaws and the Annual Strategic Plan as necessary

Goal for this change:

This details all committees with their goals and assignments in one section of the bylaws.

Budget Committee — composed of the Secretary/Treasurer and four other members shall be appointed by the newly elected Snark at the opening board meeting immediately following each annual convention.

The Chairperson for this committee will be the Secretary/Treasurer.

Goals and Assignments

- 1) It shall be the duty of this committee to prepare a budget for the approval of the Board of Directors for the fiscal year beginning August 1, to be submitted to the membership in writing at the annual meeting for their approval. Once approved by the membership no single operating expense budget item may be exceeded by more than 10% without the majority approval of the Board of Directors. No single capital expense budget item may be exceeded without the majority approval of the Board of Directors.
- 2) Perform to the bylaws and Annual Strategic Plan as necessary

Nominating Committee — composed of nine (9) members, one from each of the nine Jurisdictions. He shall appoint one of these members as Chairman. This committee shall give due consideration to all those presented as candidates for an office on the Board of Directors and determine their qualifications and eligibility for that office. It is the responsibility of this committee to put forward a qualified candidate for each office that is to be filled. Prior to the closing of nominations, any member shall have the privilege of placing an opposing qualified candidate in nomination for any of the offices to be voted on.

Following the closing of nominations, the incumbent Supreme Nine members will meet in caucus with their Jurisdictions to tally the votes of each club for the office of Snark of the Universe, Vice President, and of Secretary-Treasurer. The written tally of these votes will be presented by each Supreme Nine member to the Executive Secretary to be tallied in the presence of two scrutinizers appointed by the Snark from the delegates at large and the results presented to the Convention. Each Jurisdiction will elect its Supreme Nine member at this caucus and the results of their decision presented to the Executive Secretary at the same time. The Snark of the Universe is deemed to be the first elected followed by the 1st and then the Secretary-Treasurer regardless of the order in which the announcements are made. The election of the Supreme Nine members will be deemed to have taken place following the election of the officers.

- 1) Perform to the bylaws and the Annual Strategic Plan as necessary

Resolutions Committee — composed of four (4) members

Administration Committee — composed of five (5) members

- 1) As set out in the Annual Strategic Plan



Legislation & Good Of The Order Committee — composed of nine (9) members: three (3) Rameses + three (3) Supreme Nines + three (3) lay members

Goals and Assignments

- 1) Review and amend if necessary any changes to the bylaws and make recommendation to the board for updating and bringing them current
- 2) Any recommended ritual changes must have been reviewed and approved by the Rameses on this committee

Membership Committee — composed of 1st VP + three (3) Rameses

Goals and Assignments

- 1) As set out in the Annual Strategic Plan

Convention Committee — composed of at least three (3) members

Goals and Assignments

- 1) Establish host clubs and locations for future conventions
 - a. Communicate with local club officers to gauge interest and follow up with those that are interested
 - b. Secure the commitment from the host club by collecting a completed “application to hold an international convention” form
- 2) Make recommendations as to how to make conventions attractive and affordable for as many members as possible. More attendees create more excitement about Hoo-Hoo
- 3) Maintain a current list of clubs that have made commitments to host future conventions and make it available to the HHI board
- 4) Prepare the next two host clubs to deliver a presentation at the next convention
- 5) Stay in touch with the host clubs and make sure they have the help they need and to keep them on track.
 - a. The new convention-planning tool will be very helpful and should be offered to every host or potential host club as a tool
 - b. Report any concerns to the Snark and seek direction

Operations Manual Committee — composed of 1st VP + 2 Rameses + 2 lay members + 1 board member

Goals and Assignments

- 1) Review and recommend updates for operations manual at the mid-year board meeting if possible and no later than the pre-convention meeting
 - a. Implement updates upon approval
- 2) Bring current the convention planning section of the operations manual
- 3) Make sure each local club officer has a copy of the most current operations manual. Submit a written report to the board at the pre-convention meeting

Forest Products Education Committee — composed of three (3) members

Goals and Assignments

- 1) As set out in the Annual Strategic Plan

Redwood Grove Committee

- 1) As set out in the Annual Strategic Plan

Advertising Committee — composed of three (3) members + editor of the LOG & TALLY magazine

Goals and Assignments

- 1) As set out in the Annual Strategic Plan

Section 2: Other Committees

Such other “special” committees shall be appointed by the Snark as the Board of Directors or the membership when, from time to time, it is deemed necessary to carry on the work of the Order.

Goal for this change:

For the Good of the Order the additional task for the Vice President will allow the newly elected Snark of the Universe to hit the ground running with an updated Annual Strategic Plan.

Amend Article 8, Section 2

Article 8, Section 2 — Vice President

The Vice President shall, in the absence or disability of the Snark of the Universe, perform the function of Snark of the Universe.

The Vice President will also serve as Chairman of the Standing Committee on Membership and shall see that the Boards policy on recruitment, retention, and reinstatement is carried out.

The Vice President will also serve as Chairman of the Advertising Committee for the LOG & TALLY.

In the interest of continuity, it is the duty of the 1st VP to review and update the International Concatenated Order of Hoo-Hoo Annual Strategic Plan before taking office as the Snark of the Universe.

Ride the Wave to Success!

Share the key to your club's best project and win the Hoo-Hoo International Activity Award



Does your club have a project it takes pride in? Are you doing something to help others? Educate children? Promote the forest products industry? Share your project's story and you could win top HHI honors.

History of the Activity Award

At the Hoo-Hoo International convention in Boston in 1997, Rameses 79 Jack Jacobson was asked to chair, along with Rameses 78 Al Meier, a round table discussion regarding the Wood Promotion Award and The Jack Cheshire Media Award. There had been very little participation of clubs vying for those awards over the previous few years. It seems as if the clubs that *do* have projects did not always have a project that matched the criteria for either of those awards.

After considerable discussion on the subject it was decided that an award from a broadened criteria should be created. An award that would not only cover media coverage and the use of wood, but also cover education and community projects as well. The award would be named the “Hoo-Hoo International Activity Award”.

At the Hoo-Hoo International Board of Directors meeting in October 1997, the board agreed to retire the Wood Promotion Award and the Jack Cheshire Media Award. Furthermore, the board voted to approve the new annual Activity Award beginning in 1998, and requested a trophy be created in its honor.

Rules Governing the Hoo-Hoo International Activity Award

1. The club may submit all projects adopted by the club including National Forest Products Week.
2. The entrant club will make its presentation to the judges at the convention. The project must be submitted by the club delegate or his representative, who must be conversant with the project from start to finish. He or she may be interviewed by the judges. The evidence may consist of newspaper clippings, photos, video and/or other audio visual means. Necessary equipment needed for the presentation will be provided. We ask that the presenting club notify Hoo-Hoo International one month prior to the convention of their needs.
3. Each participating club must submit a written outline of the project to contain the following:
 - a. A description of the project;
 - b. The goal of the subject;
 - c. The method of operation;
 - d. The relative proportion of financial and/or manpower support by club.

4. **Do Not Send Club Contest Materials to the International Office.** The club delegate or the club representative is responsible for bringing the material to the convention.
5. Decision of the judges will be final. A trophy will be awarded for first place, certificates will be given to second and third place winners. No judge shall be appointed who is a member of the club making a presentation.
6. Judging will be based on the following:
 1. Membership participation based on the size of the club.
 2. Effect on the community
 3. Presentation
 4. Quality and originality of the project
 5. Recognition to local club and/or Hoo-Hoo International.



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We thank the men and women who came out to support our charity groups at the Don Gregson Memorial Golf Tournament on May 20, 2016 at the San Dimas Golf Course. In the past 10 years proceeds from this tournament have exceeded \$100,000 — with more added this year! Club 117 thanks all the golfers, sponsors, and supporters for making our efforts a success.

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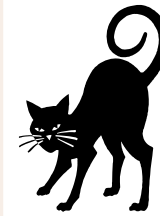
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
