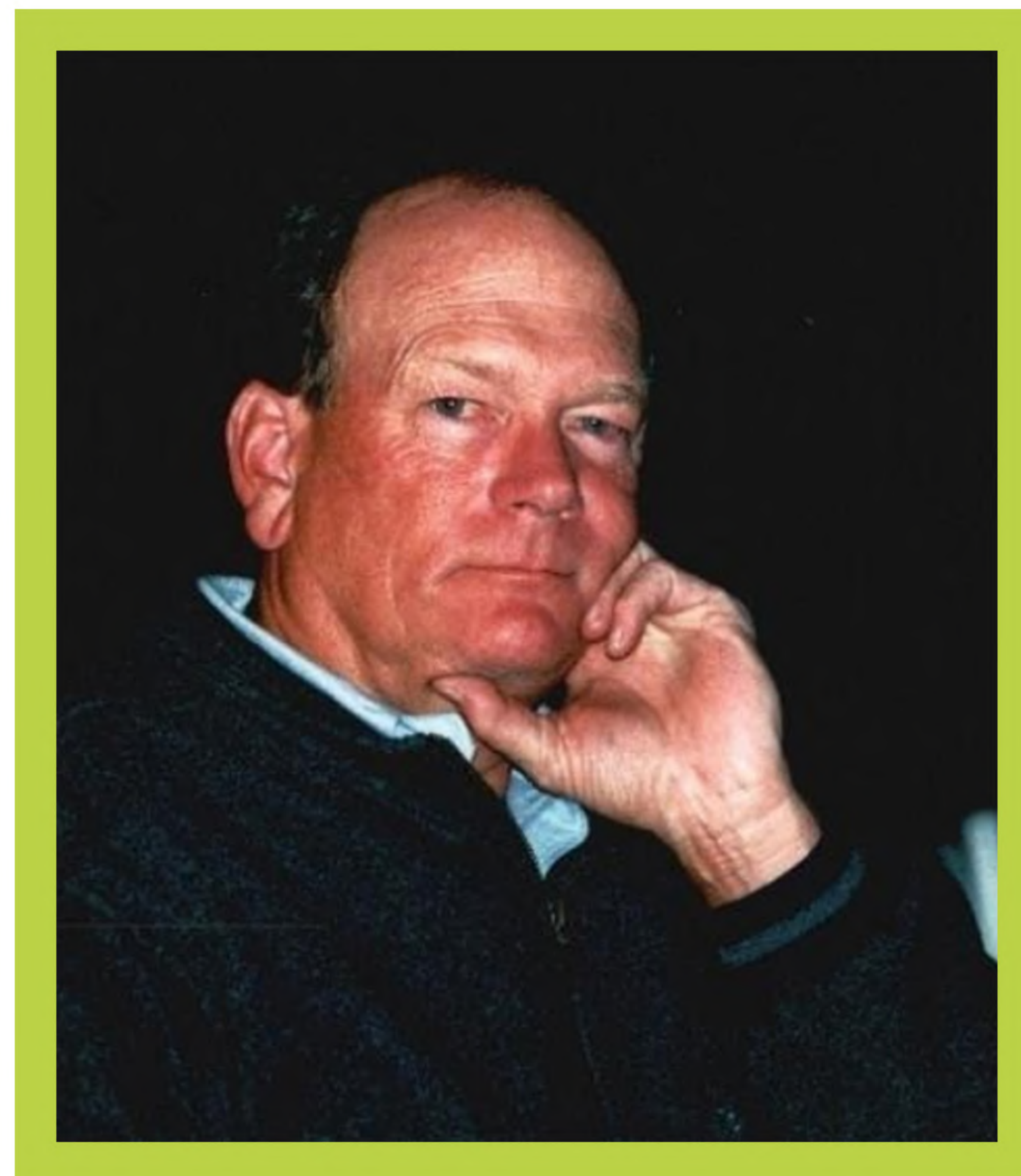
Wellington R Burt II, "Toby", passed away peacefully in his home on August 20th, 2020 after a two and a half year battle with cancer.
