The Alamo is a historic Spanish mission and fortress compound founded in the 18th century by Roman Catholic missionaries in what is now San Antonio, Texas, United States. It was the site of the Battle of the Alamo in 1836, a pivotal event of the Texas

Revolution in which American folk heroes James Bowie and Davy Crockett were killed. Today it is a museum in the Alamo Plaza Historic District and a part of the San Antonio Missions World Heritage Site.

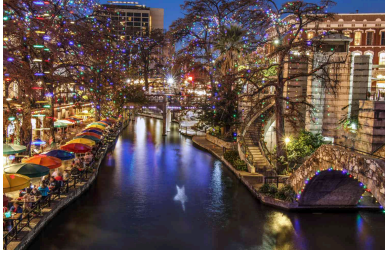

The tower was built in 1968 for the HemisFair World's Fair. The fair celebrated San Antonio's 250th anniversary. Construction of the tower began in 1966 and was completed in 18 months. In 2019 the tower turned 50 years old. Known locally as "The Tower", this is the tallest observation tower in Texas, and was

the tallest in the U.S. from 1968 until it was surpassed by the Stratosphere Tower, Las Vegas in 1996. The Tower now features a revolving Chart House Restaurant, an indoor and outdoor observation deck, a cafe, a gift shop and a 4D theatre show titled, "Skies Over Texas."
