RECIPE FOR MONTH – Fried Eggs

Eggs – fresh are best for a high yolk – make sure they are at room temperature – straight out of the fridge lends to overcooking the yolk before setting the egg white.

Frying – "butter is better" but duck fat or bacon fat will add that extra flavour touch. Peanut or olive oil if you're being plebeian.

Heat the frying pan on a medium heat and put in tablespoon of butter (2 eggs) – when butter is melted swirl around pan and turn down heat.

Break eggs into a saucer or cup (nothing more off putting then breaking a crook egg direct into pan).

Slide egg into butter and fry for 3½ minutes - a lid over will ensure more even cooking if not cooking "over easy" – If cooking "over easy" gently flip the eggs with spatula and cook for another 30 sec to minute.

(For deep frying use a cup of Extra Virgin oil and egg will be done in approx. 1 minute – remove with slotted kitchen slice) – give crispy edges Season with salt & pepper and garnish with chives or parsley.
